

Lesson 4: Auto Shadow Work

Open the Software

1. **Open** the software by **double-clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.
3. Select **File->Open**. Then, locate, select, and open the **AL_04_AutoShadowWork.waf** file located here: (C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\02_Advanced Lessons\AL_04_AutoShadowWork.waf)

Convert Artwork Shapes to Auto Shadow Work

1. Notice in the design that it contains both embroidery stitch objects and artwork objects.
2. Select the **Red flower** object.
3. Click on the **convert to Auto Shadow Work** icon. This will convert the artwork to a shadow work object. Notice in the sequence view there is now 2 color sequences dedicated to the red flower.

Modify the Shadow Work Stitches

1. **Click to expand** the **first color sequence** in the sequence view that contains the two red flower fill stitches.
2. **Select** the **two Red flower fill stitch patterns**. Then, do the following in the sequence view:
 - Input **1.40** for the Density (mm).
 - Press **Apply**.
3. Click off the design to deselect it. Then, make sure the 3D view is turned on so you can see the design in a realistic view.
4. 12. Do a **Slow Redraw** to watch the steps.
5. Click the **Print Preview** to see the design notes.

Save the Design

1. Select **File** from the menu bar and then select **Save As**.
2. Save the file in the following folder: C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\02_Advanced Lessons\
3. Name the file **AT_04**, choose **WAF** for the format, and then click **Save**.
