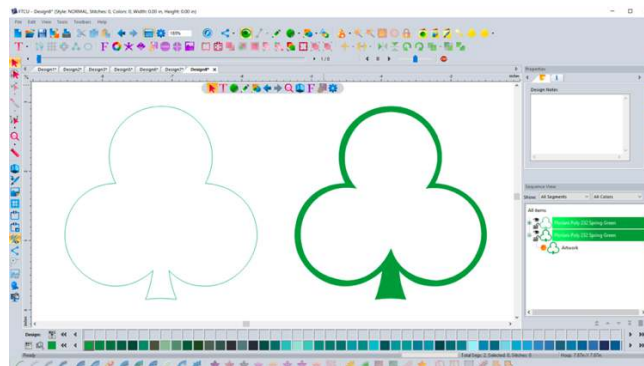


Lesson 3A - Artwork Creation Tools

Introduction Video that shows the Artwork tool and how to select and use it.

Open the Software

1. **Open** the software by **double-clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.
3. Select **File->Open**. Then, locate, select, and open the **02_L3.waf** file located here:
(C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\01_General Lessons\02_Tools for Creating\ 02_L3.waf)



Left Clover

1. **Select** the **first clover** (far left clover).
2. In the properties box, change the **Pen width (mm):** to **2.0**. Then, press **Apply**. This will change the appearance of the line by making the line look wider/bolder.
3. With it still selected, change the pen width back to **0.0** and press **Apply**.
4. Next, with it still selected, **check** the **Fill** box. Then, press **Apply**. This will fill the shape in with color. It should look like the clover on the far right.
5. Now, with it still selected, **uncheck** the **Fill** box and then press **Apply** to get it back to the original.

Right Clover

1. **Select** the **right clover**.
2. In the **properties box**, notice the **Fill** check box is selected. This is a Combined object, so it fills in different.
3. **Uncheck** the **Fill** check box and then press **Apply**. Notice there is an inner and outer line to this shape.
4. In the **sequence view**, locate this object and notice that even though there are two visible lines it is still listed as a single object. This is because the two lines were combined, making it a single object.
5. With the right clover still selected, **right-click** on it and select the **Break Apart** option. Then, look at the sequence view and notice that there are now two objects listed in the color sequence for this object.
6. Next, select **Undo** to bring it back to a combined object.

Close the Design

1. Click **File->Close** to close this design.
2. When asked if you want to save the changes, select **No**.
