Lesson 2D - Gap Slice Path Tool

Open the Software

- 1. **Open** the software by **double-clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
- 2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.
- 3. Select **File->Open**. Then, locate, select, and open the **05_L2d.wa**f file located here: (C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\01_General Lessons\05_Tools for Editing\ 05_L2d.waf)

Slice the objects

- 1. Select the **heart** design.
- 2. Next, select the Gap Slice Path knife tool.
- 3. Slice the heart by doing the following:
 - Left-click just outside of the heart on its left side.
 - Move the cursor to just outside of the heart on the right side and then left-click to add a point.
 - Next, right-click to open the Gap Slice Path dialog box.
 - Then, input 0.5 in the Offset (in): box, make sure the Close paths box is checked, and then press Apply. This will allow you to see the change made to the offset.
 - Next, click OK to apply the gap slice path on the design page. You will see a gap cut out in the heart.

Save the Design

- 1. Select File from the menu bar and then select Save As.
- 2. Save the file in the following folder: C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\01_General Lessons\05_Tools for Editing\
- 3. Name the file TFEDIT_02d, choose WAF for the format, and then click Save.
