Lesson 2E - Overlap Slice Path Tool

Open the Software

- 1. **Open** the software by **double-clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
- 2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.
- Select File->Open. Then, locate, select, and open the 05_L2e.waf file located here:
 (C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\01_General Lessons\05_Tools for Editing\ 05_L2e.waf)

Slice the objects

- 1. Select the **Panthers** design.
- 2. Next, select the **Overlap Slice Path** knife tool.
- 3. Slice the Panther design by doing the following:
 - Left-click above the letter t where the Vertical and Horizontal Guidelines meet.
 - Move the cursor down to where the Vertical and Horizontal Guidelines meet below the design, then left-click to add a point.
 - Next, right-click to open the Overlap Slice Path dialog box.
 - Then, input 0.3 in the Offset (in): box, make sure the Close paths box is checked, and then press Apply. This will allow you to see the change made to the offset.
 - Next, click OK to apply the overlap slice path on the design page. You will see the design cut where the slice was placed along with overlap.

Save the Design

- 1. Select File from the menu bar and then select Save As.
- 2. Save the file in the following folder: C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\01_General Lessons\05 Tools for Editing\
- 3. Name the file **TFEDIT_02e**, choose **WAF** for the format, and then click **Save**.
