Lesson 4 - Overlapping & Touching Applique Pieces

Open the Software

- 1. **Open** the software by **double clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
- 2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.
- 3. Select **File->Open**. Then, locate, select, and open the **TL_02_OverlappingApplique.waf** file located here: (C:\Floriani\Designs\00_FTCU LESSONS\03_Technique Lessons\TL_02_OverlappingApplique.waf)

Create Applique Pieces

- 1. Create the Placement and Tack down stitches for each applique piece as seen in the video.
- 2. Then, create the Border Stitch Outlines with a 4mm wide outline with the artwork tool as seen in the video.
- 3. Next, digitize over the top of the Border Stitch Outlines with the Satin stitch tool.

Create the Standard Embroidery Pieces

1. Digitize the standard embroidery objects as seen in the video.

Organize the Designs

- 1. Organize all the pieces of the design so the stitch in the correct positions a seen in the video.
- 2. Next, add Notes to the design where applicable as shown in the video.

Do a Slow Redraw

- 1. To ensure the design is stitching in the correct order, do a slow redraw.
- 2. Then, open the Print Preview to ensure the Notes are in their correct order.

Save the Design

- 1. Select File from the menu bar and then select Save As.
- 2. Save the file in the following folder: C:\Floriani\Designs\00 FTCU LESSONS\03 Technique Lessons
- 3. Name the file TL_03, choose WAF for the format, and then click Save.
