Lesson 6: Creating a Name Patch

Open the Software

- 1. **Open** the software by **double clicking** on the **Floriani** icon on your desktop.
- 2. When the **My Floriani Today** window appears, select the **Create A New Design** button to open a new design.

Add the Name

- 1. Select the **Text** tool.
- 2. Next, using **all capital letters**, **type a name** (your choice) in the text input box inside the **Text** properties box.
- 3. Select the **Toffee** font from the font drop down box. Then, press **Apply**.
- 4. Make sure **3D view** is on so you can see the stitches in realistic view.

Applique Patch Background

- 1. Select text you just created.
- 2. Next, click on the **Auto Nap Blocker** tool. This will automatically create a fill pattern that stitches first in the design.
- 3. Now, with the nap blocker stitches still selected, click the **Convert to Artwork** icon to turn it into artwork.
- 4. Then, right click on the artwork and choose Simplify Smoothen. A dialog window will appear.
- 5. Slide all three slides so they are all the way to the left. Then, press OK.
- 6. Next, with it still selected, click the **Convert to Applique** icon to turn it into applique. Then, apply the following in the Properties Tab for the applique:
 - 1. In the **Applique** tab in the properties box, **check the box for Sew Underlay** (all check boxes should be checked). Press **Apply**.
 - 2. In the **Corner** tab in the properties box, select **Autoturn** from the **Corner style** drop-down box. Press Apply.

Save the Design

- 1. Select **File** from the menu bar and then select **Save As**.
- 2. Save the file in the following folder: C:\Floriani\Designs\00 FTCU LESSONS\03 Technique Lessons\
- 3. Name the file **TL 06**, choose **WAF** for the format, and then click **Save**.
